- c. Online zoning map
 - i. Countywide view but only city zoning layers
 - ii. Zoom in and out, new layers will populate
- d. Function on the right side
 - i. Address search
 1. Be general, don't give too much info. Computer may bypass what you want and you will never know.
 - ii. Legend
 1. Color legend for the layers
 - iii. Layers
 1. All listed
 2. Choose what you want / need
 - iv. Info Tab
 1. PDF – instructions / data layer definitions
 2. How to video
 - v. Draw
 1. Lines, zig zags, boxes, highlight
 2. Can do distance but not easy
 - vi. Measure
 1. Distance / acres / etc.
 - vii. Print screen
 1. Creates PDF but takes time
